ELIGIBILITY:

All amateur and student artists are eligible for prize money and encouraged to submit up to three pieces of their best work. All artwork must be original and will be judged by three skill levels in each category: Amateur, Student, and Junior Student (sixteen years and younger). Professional* artists are welcome to exhibit their work, but will not be judged. Our goal is to offer a venue for local artists of all skill levels to share their talents and become better acquainted with our community.

THEME:

"Naturally Inspiring"

This event is open to artworks depicting any family-friendly subject. However, pieces created specifically for this year's theme will be eligible to win our Poster Award.

AWARDS:

Judges will award cash prizes for **Best of Show** (\$100) and **First Place** in each skill level of each category: **Best Amateur** (\$40), **Best Student** (\$30), and **Best Junior Student** (\$20). **Second Place** ribbons will also be awarded in each skill level of each category. The Elite Hall Art & Quilt Show Committee will also select a **Poster Award** winner (\$50), which will be highlighted on our promotional posters (with artist attribution) for the next show.

*We define professional artists as those who make their living primarily from selling their artwork. All other artists are eligible to be judged and should determine their skill level on their entry form.

CATEGORIES:

Entries will be judged in the following categories**

- 1. Drawing (pencil, colored pencil, pastel)
- 2. Painting (oil, acrylic, watercolor)
- 3. Photography, Graphic Arts
- 4. Fiber (all)

- 5. Pottery, Ceramics
- 6. Wood, Sculpture
- 7. Glass, Mixed Media

Two-dimensional pieces must be framed or in a protective sleeve with a stiff backing (card stock, etc.). Outside dimensions of paintings, photographs, and drawings---including frame---cannot exceed 4'x 4'. Three-dimensional work cannot exceed 6 feet in any direction or 100 lbs.

SALES:

All entries may be available for purchase during the event, however the show staff will not directly sale any items. Rather, we will provide a price list with the artist's contact information to any interested purchasers. Sold artwork cannot be removed until the end of the show.

LIABILITY:

Although reasonable care will be taken in handling and displaying artwork, the Elite Hall Art and Quilt Show, its staff, and volunteers will not be responsible for damage or loss. Artists must pick up their work(s) at the designated time and location. Artist may arrange for artwork pickup by another party with proper notification.
