Summary/Provenance Note

This collection combines two misc. photograph collections into one photograph collection. Museum staff found these collections in the museum stacks unprocessed, and formed them into their respective collections.

Content Description

This collection combines two previously separate (and still separate in PastPerfect) collections of miscellaneous accessioned photographs. Included in this new collection are several matted photographs of various people and places in Hyrum from the late 19th century and early 20th century. Among this are pictures of notable Hyrum residents, sports teams, early automobiles, and several group photographs. The smaller photographs are in folder 1, while the large matted photographs are inside the box without a folder
