### **Provenance Note**

This collection was donated by Lucille Byington in 2008. Original accession number was 2008.12, updated when the Museum reopened in 2013.

### **Historical Note**

Lucille Byington was born in 1964 to Mildred Unsworth Chambers and James William Chambers in Logan, Utah. Her mother, Mildred grew up in Hyrum, Utah, and was the granddaughter of James Unsworth, the first merchant in Hyrum. Though she lived in Smithfield with her husband and children, Mildred was very proud of her upbringing in Hyrum, and Hyrum's historical past. A few years after her death in 2005, her daughter, Lucille, donated these items to the museum in her memory.

### **Scope and Content of Collection**

This collection consists of one box of materials relating to Lucille Byington and especially her mother, Mildred Unsworth Chambers, who grew up in Hyrum. The majority of the items are Relief Society Magazines from the 1960s, and there is also a 1920 Book of Mormon, as well as two yearbooks from South Cache High School and William Budge Memorial Hospital in Logan Utah.
